Measure Authoring Tool

Current State:

- MAT 6.10 was released June 16th and is currently available to users.
- Detailed release notes and an updated user guide are available on the MAT web site under Training and Resources
- This version of the MAT supports the authoring of both the QDM/CQL using QDM version 5.6 as well as FHIR based measures.

Measure Authoring Tool

Maintenance:

- Maintenance is usually zero down time.
- Any known downtime for maintenance will be communicated to all users via email.
- Next planned maintenance release is targeted for July 21st at 8am ET.

Measure Authoring Tool

Known Issues:

1. CQL Libraries, using MAT Global Common Functions will display validation errors if FHIR Helpers is not included.

The workaround is to reinclude FHIR Helpers if it was removed during versioning of the top level CQL Library.

2. User was unable to add kg/m² into a measure and received an error message. The VSAC was not handling the '/' special character. The team is working to improve error messaging. The workaround provided was to update logic and the reference of kg/m².

3. For certain measures, a general error is displayed upon measure load, preventing the user from viewing CQL errors. This is only occurring with a few measures that have been reported. The workaround is to select save on the CQL Editor to display CQL errors as expected.

Current State:

- Bonnie Prior (QDM 5.4), Bonnie QDM (QDM 5.5) and Bonnie FHIR are all available in production environments with separate credentials.
- Bonnie 4.2.1 QDM – export test patients for FHIR
- Bonnie 6.1.2 FHIR – import test patients, calculate Supplemental Data Elements (SDE), additional attribute support

Bonnie

Maintenance:

No planned maintenance currently.

Known Issues:

1. The QRDA export is not correctly reflecting relevant date time. There is no workaround, but this will be addressed in an upcoming release.
2. For Bonnie FHIR, a measure calculation error may be encountered. The tuple naming convention requires an update. The team is working with additional contributors and will address this in an upcoming release.
3. For Bonnie FHIR, measures that include stratification are not displaying properly for users to test. There is no workaround at this time, but this will be addressed in an upcoming release.
4. Some users are not able to import FHIR converted Bonnie test patients into Bonnie FHIR. The workaround is to submit a ticket to the MAT and Bonnie Issue Tracker to request assistance importing your test cases. This is only occurring for some of our users. Enhancements to accommodate this, will be addressed in an upcoming release.

Bonnie QDM

Bonnie Release Update:

Bonnie 5.0 QDM – Releasing July 19th at 5pm ET

- Incorporate QDM 5.6
- Update QDM/CQL to CQL 1.5
- Patient data will be removed if it used deprecated 5.6 attributes
- Transition users to authentication with HARP IDs
- Group Accounts will be used
- Patient conversion functionality disabled until a future Bonnie QDM release to update patient conversion defaults (mid-July)
- Users will receive a warning after 10 minute of inactivity and logged out after 15 minutes. Options for extending this timeout will be explored for future releases.

Bonnie 5.x QDM

- Incorporate requested patient conversion default enhancements
- Reintroduce the patient conversion functionality
- This will be released when the QDM 5.6 -> FHIR conversion specification is finalized

Bonnie Prior

Bonnie Release Update:

Bonnie Prior

- Reflect Bonnie 4.2.1 and will support QDM 5.5
- Requested patient conversion defaults implemented
- Users will NOT use HARP IDs to authenticate until a future release
- Group Accounts are not be reflected

Bonnie FHIR

Planned Releases:

- Release to fix patient upload issues
- Bonnie FHIR will be releasing incrementally to add new FHIR features
 - Users will be notified when those release dates are determined.
 - Attributes adding in the release will be noted in the release notes
 - Submit requests for additional QI-Core Attribute support to the MAT and Bonnie Issue Tracker:

Bonnie FHIR

We are planning a release the second week of August to support more attributes. Expect the following Attributes:

- Condition - Severity, recorder, asserter
- Procedure - reasonCode
- Communication - Status
- ServiceRequest - reasonCode, id
- Task - Status, basedOn
- DeviceRequested -Status, intent
- Encounter - reasonCode
- MedicationAdministered -Effective
- Immunization - Occurrence
- MedicationDispense - Status, daysSupply, dosageInstruction.timing

Bonnie Transition to HARP

- Bonnie Prior, Bonnie QDM and Bonnie FHIR will all be migrating to a new CMS environment
- Bonnie QDM - Users will sign into Bonnie using their HCQIS Access Roles and Profile (HARP) IDs with Bonnie QDM 5.0
- Bonnie Prior and Bonnie FHIR will use HARP IDs following future releases – Targeting 2nd week of August
