

MADiE Known Issues

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Date Added	Issue Description
11/06/2024	QDM Measures: QRDA export will fail if a measure includes one or more test cases that have the Payer data element added, but no code selected for the data element. Work around: Update the impacted test cases to either add a code to the Payer data element or remove the Payer data element. MADiE-2043
11/16/2024	QDM Measures: Unexpected results are received for test cases that included a quantity prior to the update released with MADiE 2.0.7 on 10/12/2024. Work around: Users will need to update impacted test cases to edit the quantity and save the test case again. This will apply the update released with MADiE 2.0.7 to be applied to that test case. MADiE-2056
9/1/2026	US Quality Core Measures: MADiE adds a second US Core using statement when drafting a versioned US Quality Core stand-alone library. Work around: The library owner should remove one instance of “using USCore version ‘6.0.0-derived’” from the library CQL and save the updated library.
9/1/2026	US Quality Core Measures: The HL7 links on the Available profiles tab are currently not opening the associated US Quality Core profile pages. These links are provided for reference purposes only, and no action is required by the user. Users who need to review the profile information can access the correct US Quality Core profiles directly at the following URL: https://fhir.org/guides/ncq/us-quality-core/en/profiles.html.
9/1/2026	US Quality Core Measures: When "All Profiles" is selected on the Available Elements tab, MADiE will display several "Cross-version Profile" profiles. These profiles can be safely disregarded and do not require any action from the user.

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9/1/2026	US Quality Core Measures: Test case resources that use references defined by the US Quality Core Implementation Guide as version-specific will fail validation. For example, if a measure includes a Claim resource that references an Insurance Coverage resource, the test case will incorrectly fail validation when the Coverage reference is evaluated. Work Around: This issue will be resolved in MADiE 4.0.1, which is currently targeted for release on September 15, 2026. Until that release, users may ignore the validation error. If users need to execute test cases before the issue is resolved, they can select the "EXECUTE TEST CASES REGARDLESS OF VALIDATION STATUS" checkbox and click Save to proceed with test case execution.
